Activity	Build a Basic Shelter.	Date	25/3/2020
Aim/Activity and Instructions. The aim is to build a basic shelter from whatever resources that you have to hand that you could if, you needed, sleep out in overnight. Thinks about the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Resistance to wind?2. Is it waterproof?3. Will it be warm?4. Is it safe?5. What could go wrong in the night? You might model it on a traditional tent, or be more creative.			
Learning Outcomes: <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Resourcefulness➤ Creativity➤ Adventurous.			
Resources: Use what you can find, but make sure you ask first and check with your adult.			
Key Risk and Controls: Under lockdown you need to stay in your home or garden. Could this shelter fall on you? Is it attached to something solid. Think' what if'! and take precautions! Be careful with rope, don't get tangled! Stay safe. Once you have finished, tidy equipment away. Remember, ask an adult for help.
