Aim/Activity and Instructions.

Use a map of your local area to plan a family walk or cycle ride for today or the weekend.

Try and include the following criteria.

1. Explore – Go somewhere new – There will be lots of parts of your neighbourhood where you have not been, take this opportunity to explore.
2. Try and discover a new green space. A park or clearing, a woodland or field. (only enter if there is a public right of way).
3. Avoid main and busy roads – You will need to risk assess the route for danger and identify how you can minimise that danger or remove it. Ask yourself 'What if?'
4. Include a plan B or escape route into your journey plan, how will you get home from any point if something goes wrong?
5. Most importantly make it memorable and meaningful. Enjoy doing it with your family.
6. Share your experiences and learning with us and others!
